OVER 50 YEARS of SCHOLARSHIP

Dolphin Scholarship Foundation was established in 1960 and granted the first award of \$350 in 1961 to John L. Haines, Jr. Funds were raised primarily through the tireless efforts of submarine officers' spouses' organizations throughout the U.S.

As the cost of education continues to skyrocket, so does the need for the Foundation to assist students. Dolphin Scholarship Foundation grants are available, on a competitive basis, to high school or college children and spouses of members or former members of the Submarine Force or Navy members who have served in submarine support activities. Today, Dolphin Scholarship Foundation sponsors 118 ongoing scholarships with an annual grant of either \$2,000 or \$3,400 per student for two to four years of full-time undergraduate studies as well as students pursuing trade/vocational certification.

DSF also awards scholarships to eligible spouses working toward their first undergraduate degree or trade/vocational certification. Approximately 25-30 new scholarships are awarded each year. Scholars are selected on the basis of academic proficiency, commitment and excellence in school and community activities as well as financial need. Since our founding over 50 years ago, Dolphin Scholarship Foundation has granted over \$11,500,000 to more than 1,300 outstanding students attending fully accredited universities and colleges throughout the U.S.

Donations from submarine spouse fundraising events remain a significant portion of our income. DSF receives additional funding through private, corporate, and memorial donations as well as the **Combined Federal Campaign (#10102)**.

DSF administers the *Laura W. Bush Scholarship* for children of USS TEXAS (SSN 775) crew members, the *Nautilus Scholarship* for descendants of USS NAUTILUS crew members, the *Hampton Scholarship* for USS HAMPTON (SSN 767) crew members and their dependents, and for the USS COLORADO (SSN 788) crew members and their dependents.
