

Captain Keith B. Fargo, SC, USN (Ret)



Captain Keith Fargo's 29-year Naval career assignments involved various aspects of Supply Chain Management including procurement, inventory management, distribution/warehouse operations, equipment maintenance support and logistics IT systems. Prior to entering the Navy, received his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from the University of Southern California. He was commissioned in 1974 through the Navy's Officer Candidate School Program. While in the Navy, he attended the University of California, Berkeley and received his Master of Business Administration in 1983

As a career Navy Supply Corps Officer, he served in logistics and management assignments at shore activities and on ships including submarines. He led logistics organizations that procured and managed material ranging from commercial off-the-shelf supplies to complex nuclear reactor plant components. He served in business management positions that planned and executed financial and personnel resources. He directed joint logistics for worldwide contingency operations, including supporting the munitions, fuel, transportation, and other logistics supplies. Captain Keith Fargo retired for the Naval service in 2003. Following his Naval career, he was a consultant for Booz Allen Hamilton until 2013 supporting Logistics requirements and processes for U.S. Navy clients including the Naval Special Warfare Command located in Coronado, CA.
