## OVER SIXTY YEARS OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Dolphin Scholarship Foundation was established in 1960 and granted the first award of \$350 in 1961 to John L. Haines, Jr. Funds were raised primarily through the tireless efforts of submarine officers' spouses' organizations throughout the U.S.

As the cost of education continues to skyrocket, so does the need for the Foundation to assist students. Dolphin Scholarship Foundation grants are available, on a competitive basis, to high school or college children/stepchildren and spouses of members or former members of the Submarine Force or Navy members who have served in submarine support activities. Today, Dolphin Scholarship Foundation sponsors over 114 ongoing scholarships with an annual grant of either \$1,500 to \$3,500 per student for two to four years of full-time undergraduate studies as well as students pursuing trade/vocational certification. DSF also awards scholarships to eligible spouses working toward their first undergraduate degree or trade/vocational certification. Approximately 25-30 new scholarships are awarded each year. Scholars are selected on the basis of academic proficiency, commitment and excellence in school and community activities as well as financial need. Since our founding over 60 years ago, Dolphin Scholarship Foundation has granted over \$14,000,000 to more than 1,400 outstanding students attending fully accredited universities and colleges throughout the U.S.

Donations from submarine spouse fundraising events remain a significant portion of our income. DSF receives additional funding through private, corporate, and memorial donations.
